## Objective of the Study:-


- Identifying users' awareness in library automation.

Data Analysis: - Data Received by User






56% of users use the library for reading. 30% of

**Objective II**:- How do you get information from your library?.




In this we found that only 20 people in 50 students, 30 in 50 research scholars, 50 in 50

Both SOUL and KOHA use software at Dr. C V University. In which software people are more aware.



**Objective IV**:- To know the effect of library housekeeping activities.


Time Saving	Direct Access to Library Materials	To Know the Availability of Library Materials





**Objective VI:-** Do you use OPAC and are satisfied with it.


